RE: Net Metering Billing Policy Changes

Dear Brit:

Clallam County PUD (the PUD) conducts periodic reviews of our practices and programs to ensure compliance with our mission and applicable legislation. During a recent review of net-metering billing practices and applicable State law (RCW 80.60), we found that with the current level of subscribed customers, the PUD has surpassed our mandated interconnection obligation for offering net-metering with bill crediting in excess of generation.

As a result, at their January 8, 2018 meeting the PUD's Board of Commissioners resolved to discontinue offering net-metering with bill crediting in excess of generation to new interconnection applicants, and adopted a new Interconnection Requirements Policy. Per the new policy, effective with Interconnection Applications received on or after February 1, 2018, the PUD will credit excess kilowatt-hours, at an effective wholesale energy rate. The effective wholesale rate shall be updated annually, and will be based on the preceding year's billed power purchase costs divided by total kilowatt-hours sold. A new rate will be posted which go into effect on February 1 annually (section 9. T. of the attached document).
